1. Information on cookies and their use

(1) Cookies are small text files stored by a website, application, script or other IT system on a target computer, tablet, smartphone or other device of the end user, containing information about browsing or use of online content by the user. Cookies are essential in the operation of modern websites, facilitating navigation and interaction with such platforms, as well as identifying the device, location or user preferences. Cookies used on this website cannot harm your device, because they are not a program but only a method of storing information.

(2) Concerning this Cookie Policy, by "cookies" we also refer to other similar technologies for installing and / or collecting information on the user's device (such as flash cookies, beacons or web errors, HTML5 technologies such as local storage and SDK for application formats). Likewise, the term "cookies" also refers to the use of fingerprinting, i.e. techniques of combining information that help us identify your device.

(3) Depending on the owner of cookies, they can be divided into:

(a) own Cookies - files sent to the user's computer or device from a computer or domain managed by the publisher itself;

(b) third party cookies - the files sent to the user's computer or device from a computer or domain that is not managed by the publisher but by another entity that processes data obtained through cookies.

(4) Cookies used on our website are divided into four groups depending on their functions:

(a) technical files - the files that allow you to navigate the website, platform or application and to use various options or services (i.e. traffic control, data or session identification, access to restricted sections or content, remembering the items that constitute the order, processing the order, managing payments, preventing fraud related to the service security, the use of security elements during navigation, making a registration application or participation in an event, storing content for video or audio broadcasting, incorporating dynamic content) - these files are necessary for the correct functioning of the website;

(b) functional files - the cookies that allow you to keep information enabling access to a service or platform with specific characteristics which may differ from those sought by other users (e.g. language, number of results to be displayed, website appearance or content depending on the browser type) - failure to accept these cookies may result in slowing down the website;

(c) analytical files - the files that allow to quantify the number of users, sections visited on the platform and the manner in which users interact with it, in order to carry out measurement and statistical analysis;

(d) behavioural files - the files that store information about the behavior of users obtained through the continuous observation of their browsing habits, on basis of which a specific advertising display profile is determined.

2. Cookies management

(1) You may manage consents to the use of cookies on our website in the configuration panel available at any time on our website. At the same time, you can disable cookies in your browser. The option to avoid the use of cookies is available at any time.

(2) The management of the cookie configuration panel and the use of appropriate browser options affects only a specific device and a specific browser, and must be set separately for each device.

(3) With respect to third party cookies, in order to deliver advertising based on your interests some third parties may be members of any of the following self-regulatory online behavioral advertising programs, which provide appropriate opt-out options:
